**May 27th:** All registrations due with \$50.

**June 21st:** Balance of the trip is due with all paper work .

July 20th: We will work some more at the Ministry Center and spend the rest of the day relaxing a little and do some tourism type things before camp begins

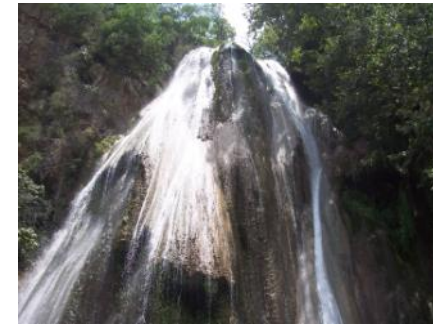
